

**Michigan HOSA
2021 Michigan HOSA
State Officer Candidate Process**

Round One

Complete and submit the online Michigan HOSA Officer Candidate Application. A selected committee will review your application. The committee will determine your eligibility to run for State HOSA Office.

You will receive an email confirming your application has been reviewed and if you have or have not been selected to run as a candidate for Michigan HOSA State HOSA Office.

Round Two

If you are selected as an officer candidate, you are required to complete the following tasks:

1. Conduct a virtual interview with the Michigan HOSA staff
 - We will contact you and coordinate a virtual meeting
2. Create a campaign video (not to exceed three minutes) and post to YouTube
 - Creatively introduce yourself and share why you would like to serve as a Michigan HOSA state officer
 - Once uploaded to YouTube, please email link to hosa@mhc.org, we will add it to our Michigan HOSA State Officer page for schools to watch
 - Videos are how each school will determine their vote for state officers
3. Take an online exam evaluating your HOSA knowledge
 - 25 question test evaluating your HOSA knowledge
 - Resources include Sections A, B & C of the HOSA Handbook, www.hosa.org, www.michiganhosa.org, Robert's Rules of Order
4. Conduct a second virtual interview with the current Michigan HOSA state officer team
 - We will contact you and coordinate a virtual meeting

Election Details

Five candidates are elected to Michigan HOSA office. Officers acquiring the most amount of points are elected to serve as officers during the 2021-2022 school year.

Points are acquired as follows:

Online HOSA Exam = 25 possible points (1 point for each correct answer)

Interview with current officer team = 10 possible points (rated by current officers)

Each HOSA School Vote = ~125 possible points (1 point for each HOSA school vote)

Elected Officers are slated into positions according to their choice selected in the Michigan HOSA Officer Candidate Application. The elected officer with the most points will have his/her first choice of officer position. For example if 'Joe Schmoe' acquired the most amount of points and selected President as his first choice, he would be slated in the President position. The elected officer with the second highest amount of points will then have his/her choice of office as long as it has not previously been chosen.

Elected candidates are announced during the 2021 Michigan HOSA Grand Awards Ceremony.
